After you have signed up, it's time to let everyone know you're taking part! You could promote your classes Hedgehog Walk by...

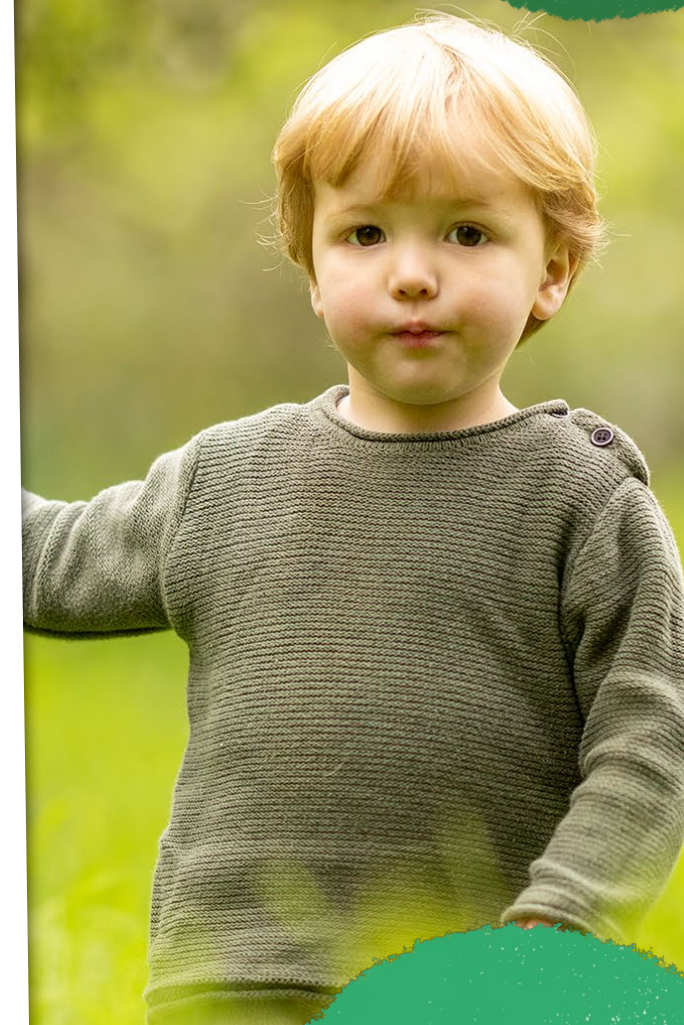
- Printing posters from our resource pages to decorate your classroom or playroom
