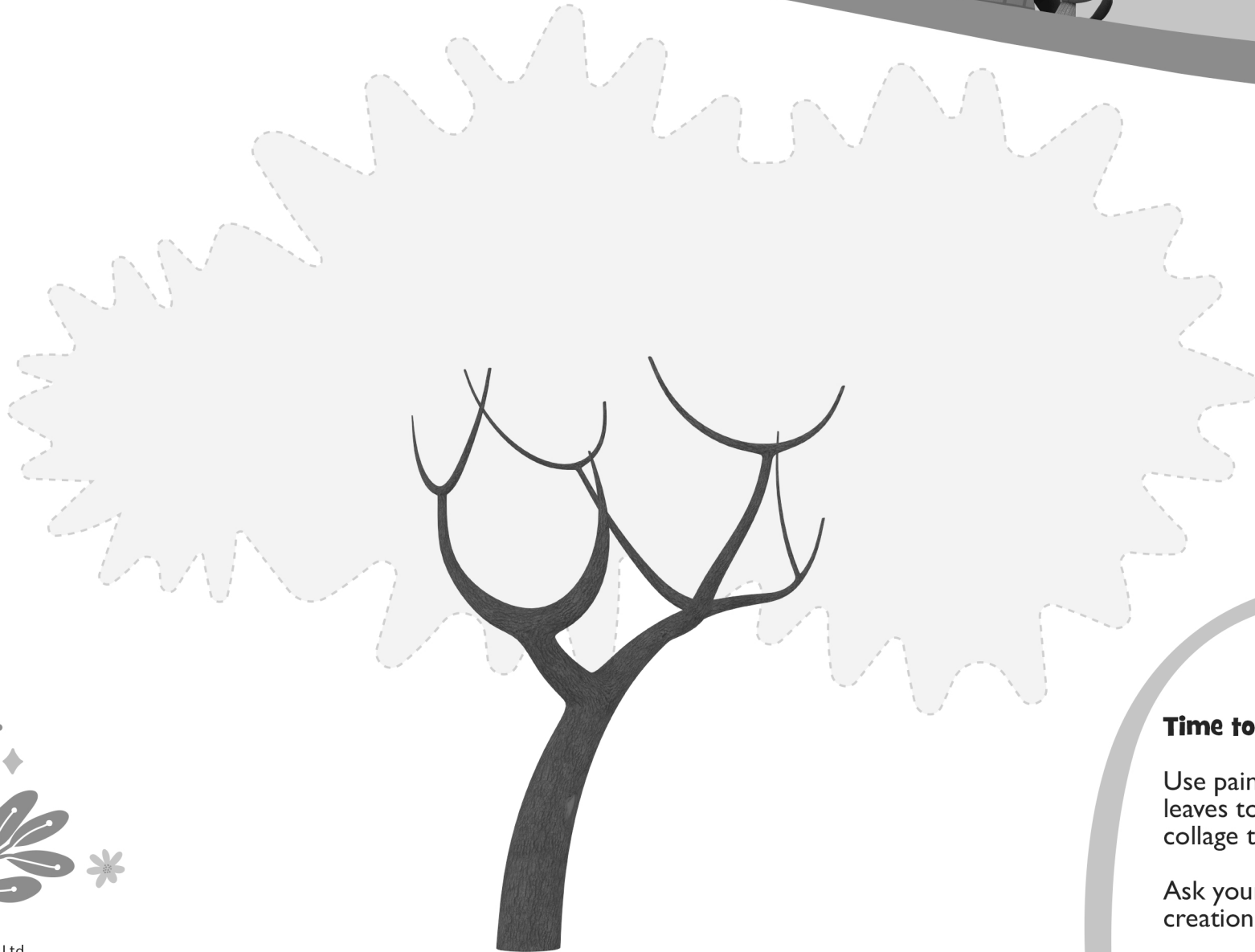

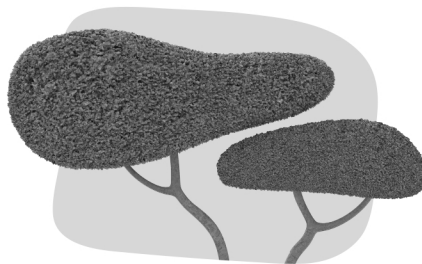

Being outdoors can make us feel great and turn every day into an adventure. How many can you tick off?



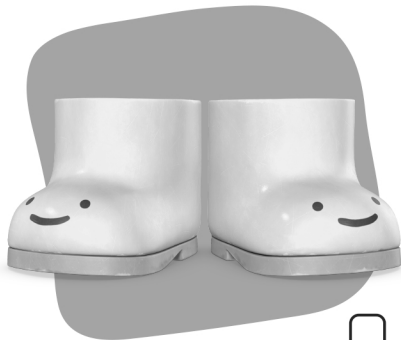

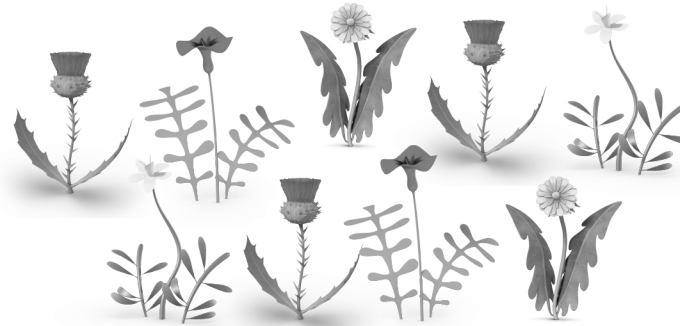

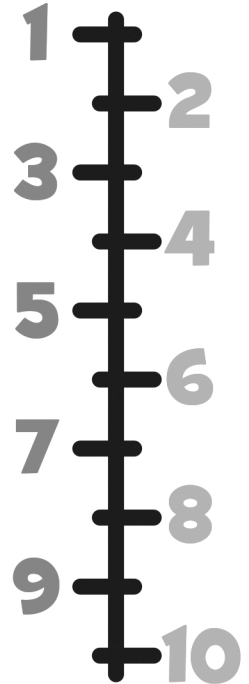

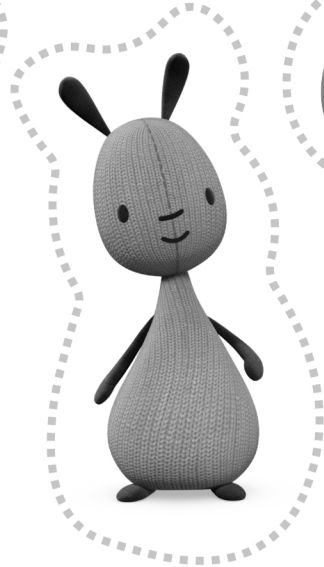


Look carefully! There are five differences between the two pictures of Bing, Flop and Sula. Can you find and circle them all?

Create your own adventure. Help Bing and friends explore the park, discover wildlife, or go on a nature walk.

How to make your puppet theatre

1. Print out the sheets for your park background and characters
2. Take a small cardboard box like a shoe box. Take off the lid and stick the background to the bottom of your box.
3. Stand the box on its side to create your stage.
4. Carefully cut around each Bing, Flop and Sula character. Ask a grown-up to help.

5. Use glue or tape to stick a clean lollipop stick, straw or twig to the back of your cutout character so you can hold your puppet and move it around.

6. Place your stage outside on the grass or on a windowsill on rainy days.

7. Hold your puppets and move them across the stage to act out your story.

Extra tip: Decorate with fallen leaves, petals and sticks.

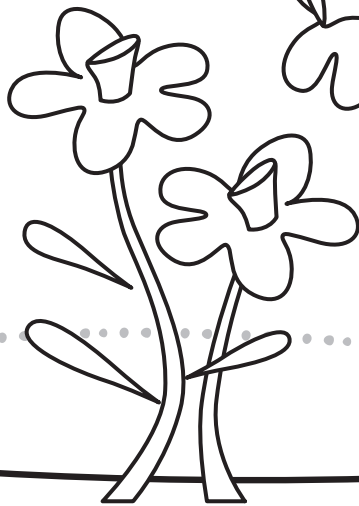
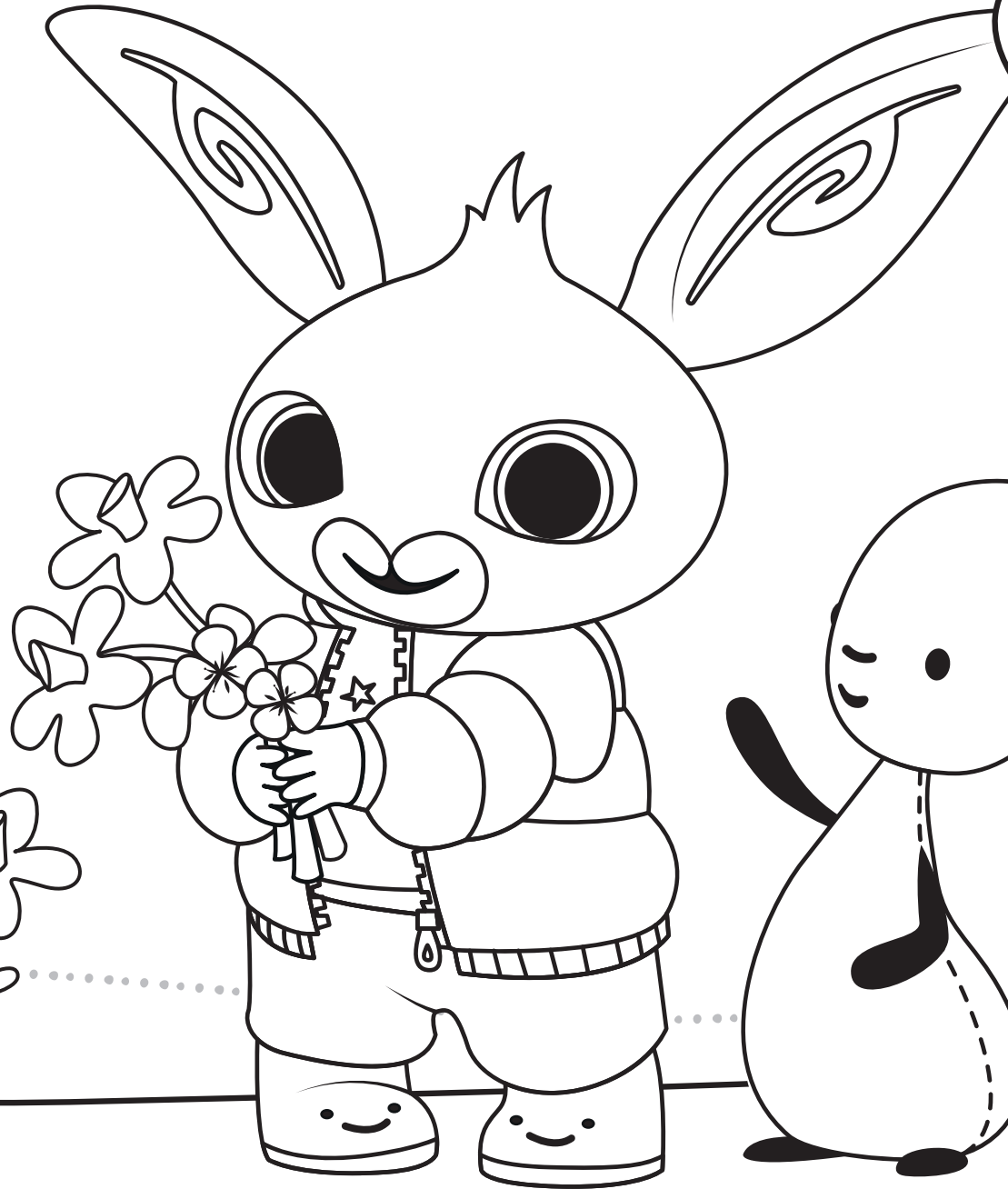
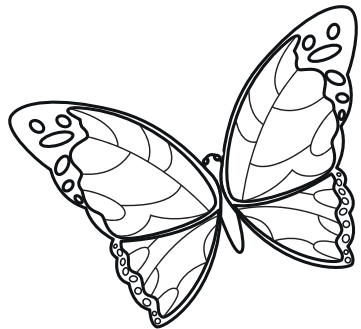
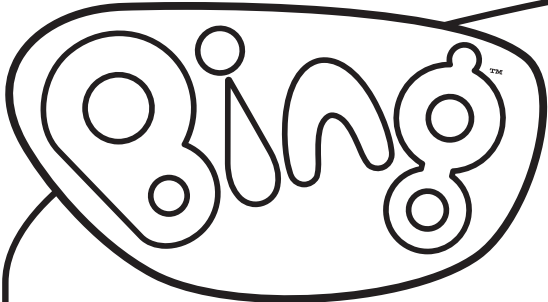
